

Enjoy Surrey's natural beauty in springtime

The most wooded county in England, though all too frequently overlooked, come and explore the beauty of Surrey's woodland, stunning views, river banks or canal paths as well as the vast choice of National Trust land and gardens.



Morning

See the [Bluebells at Winkworth Arboretum](#), Godalming (Entry £5.90, free for members)

Wander round this tranquil hillside arboretum which contains over 1,000 shrubs and trees. Although perfect as an all-year-round venue, don't miss the spring's colourful blossoms (magnolias, rhododendrons, bluebells and azaleas)

Lunch with stunning views at [Newlands Corner](#), Guildford or enjoy the climb to **St Martha's Chapel, Chilworth** and be rewarded by the views over Albury and Guildford. Down the hill you'll discover the disused gunpowder works!

Afternoon

[Painshill Park, Cobham](#) (Entry £5.80)

See snowdrops in spring and step into a 'living work of art' and discover 158 acres of magnificent 18th century Georgian landscape and lake. Enjoy unusual follies, an amazing crystal Grotto, a Vineyard and spectacular views across Surrey.

[RHS Garden Wisley](#) (£9.50)

With seasonal interest throughout the garden. Early spring begins with witch hazels and snowdrops with bolder colours from daffodils and tulips following. Late spring brings vibrant colours from the rhododendrons and azaleas
