Description (150 words)	<p>Guildford House Gallery is a fascinating Grade I Listed Building, a town house built in 1660, located in the heart of historic Guildford. The house contains many original features including decorative wrought ironwork on the windows, wood panelling on the walls, decorative plasterwork ceilings and a stunning carved staircase decorated with carved flora and fauna. Initially a family residence, Guildford House Gallery was used as business premises before being bought by Guildford Borough Council and is now used as the Borough's art gallery. A varied programme of public art exhibitions are shown throughout the year which include photography, craft, textiles, paintings, as well as work on show from the Borough Collection in specific exhibitions. The Gallery also boasts an excellent gift shop and café. Prebooked unfacilitated schools visits are welcome to look at the exhibitions and view the House itself. The Gallery is open Tuesday-Saturday, 10am to 4.45pm and admission is free.</p>

Description (150 words)	<p>Guildford Museum founded in 1898 and now houses the largest collection of archaeology, local history and needlework in Surrey. Located in Quarry Street, just off Guildford's historic High Street, the Museum is open Monday – Saturday 11am to 4.45pm. The Museum hosts changing temporary exhibitions through the year. Objects on permanent display include a 400,000 year old hand axe from Swanscombe in Kent and a napkin used by Queen Elizabeth I which features her embroidered portrait and an image of <a href="#">St George</a> slaying the Dragon. There is an extensive list of loan boxes available for schools to borrow. Schools can also visit our Victorian Schoolroom (KS2) and Victorian Playroom (KS1) and immerse themselves in learning about life for Victorian schoolchildren. Guided tours of historic Guildford town can also be arranged with the town guides from May to September. Visits to Guildford Castle can also be arranged through the Museum. The Museum has a shop with an excellent range of reasonably priced gifts for sale.</p>
